INSURANCE INFORMATION: Certificate of insurance should include the owner's name, and the year, make and model of the boat, the insurance company name, policy number, dates of coverage and limits of liability

GENERAL INFORMATION: Any slip owner who is renting their slip this season must also submit the form **JONATHAN'S LANDING BOAT SLIP RENTAL AGREEMENT** with the tenant's information, tenant's boat registration, and tenant's certificate of insurance.

Boats may not exceed a length overall 26 feet and width of 9 feet. For boats longer than 20 feet, lines connected to dock posts, walkway posts or dock cleats should be fitted with the appropriate sized snubbers. A minimum of 2 snubbers per boat is required. The length and width of boats may not create a hazard to navigation, nor interfere with entry or egress from another slip. No refueling is allowed at the docks. Damage caused to a boat slip will be the responsibility of the slip owner.
